Dear Speaker Johnson and Leader Jeffries:

The undersigned organizations, representing a broad cross-section of stakeholders, urge the House of Representatives to promptly consider and advance the BUILD America 250 Act. The legislation reflects the longstanding bipartisan recognition that a safe and reliable transportation system is essential to the nation's economy and quality of life.

With current surface transportation law set to expire on September 30, timely action is critical to provide the certainty needed for states and local governments to plan and deliver infrastructure projects in communities across the country. A long-term surface transportation authorization is essential to maintaining and improving the highways, bridges, public transportation systems, freight networks, and safety programs that Americans and the economy depend upon every day.

The BUILD America 250 Act would provide greater certainty for public agencies and private-sector partners, strengthen the movement of people and goods, support domestic manufacturing and supply chains, improve transportation safety, and sustain well-paying jobs throughout the economy. Predictable federal investment allows transportation agencies to develop long-term plans, make more efficient use of public resources, and avoid project disruptions and cost increases caused by uncertainty.

The bill also includes policies intended to improve project delivery, strengthen the long-term outlook of the Highway Trust Fund, support workforce development, and enhance the safety and reliability of the transportation system. These investments and reforms will help ensure America remains competitive in the global economy while addressing growing infrastructure needs.

We respectfully urge House leadership to bring the BUILD America 250 Act to the floor for consideration to demonstrate a continued bipartisan commitment to the transportation system that strengthens communities nationwide.
