Dear Majority Leader Thune and Minority Leader Schumer:

The Pesticide Policy Coalition (PPC) appreciates Senate Agriculture Committee Chairman John Boozman for developing a Farm Bill discussion draft that helps support the timely, science-based review of the crop protection tools farmers, growers, and land managers depend on every day. Access to safe and effective pesticides is essential to protecting crops, managing invasive pests, supporting agricultural productivity, and ensuring a secure food supply. The provisions included in the Senate Farm Bill discussion draft help strengthen regulatory certainty and improve the review process for these critical tools while maintaining rigorous safety standards.

The PPC is a coalition of organizations that represent millions of American farmers, growers, and the broader ecosystem of agriculture, food, fiber, public health, pest management, landscape, environmental, and related industries who support sound science and the risk-based regulation of pesticides. PPC members and represented stakeholders use pesticides to safely grow crops, to adopt conservation practices such as conservation tillage and resource-saving crop rotations, to protect homes and infrastructure, to control pathogens and disease vectors, and to maintain green spaces.

The Coalition supports the Senate Farm Bill discussion draft and urges Senators from both sides of the aisle to work together to advance this important bipartisan legislation. America's farmers and growers need a modern Farm Bill that provides certainty, strengthens agricultural competitiveness, and preserves access to the tools necessary to produce abundant, affordable, and sustainable food, fiber, and horticultural products.
